Distance

8km (4½ miles)

Time Required

2½ to 4 hours

Terrain/Accessibility

This is a strenuous walk with a large number of steps along the full route, the trail follows a well defined footpath and is unsuitable for wheelchairs and pushchairs.

Safety

Please read and follow all warning signs.
Suitable footwear must be worn (eg. walking boots or strong shoes).
Children must be supervised at all times.
Please take extra care at certain times of the year when paths may be slippery.

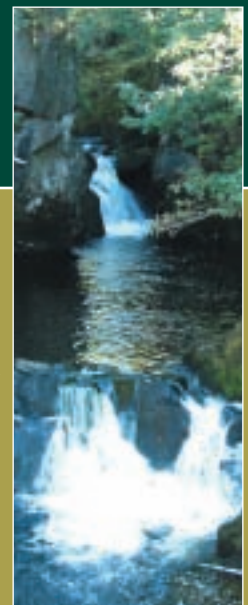

Visit the Waterfalls Trail in Ingleton and enjoy a 4½ mile circular walk through attractive woodland and dales scenery via a series of spectacular waterfalls. The trail first opened to the public in 1885 and has continued to attract visitors ever since!

Wildlife along the Trail

Rare and interesting plants, birds and trees can be seen along the trail, most of which Natural England has notified as a Site of Special Scientific Interest, mainly because of its impressive geological features and wide range of unusual lichens, ferns and mosses.

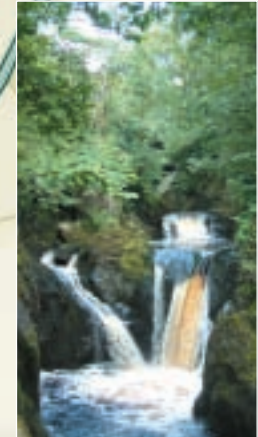
The Falls Cafe & Gift Shop
